Put a piece of electrical tape over the camera and you're fine. The greater danger however is the built-in mic. Audio recordings are far more incriminating than video as it can hear anything that the camera's limited view cannot film. Furthermore it is possible to extract your passwords by listening to sound patterns of the keyboard keys as it's being typed. So if you truly need the privacy and security you'll need to either desolder the builtin mic (very carefully), or purchase a laptop that has a physical killswitch for the mic (very expensive. but a good example is Purism's Librem laptops).
